The Orchestre National de Jazz launches the new season of the ONJ Youth Orchestra, a program for European students who want to get involved in an orchestra project.

Project manager: Marianne Clair.

Artistic and administrative coordination: Jean-Charles Richard.

LIKELY CANDIDATES

Students from French and European higher education centers of artistic education.

Students in either a specialist-curriculum or preparatory class for higher education at a conservatory or music academy.

- AIMS

The ONJ Youth Orchestra is a unique project created in 2018, which allows students to play with other musicians from different regions of France and Europe, to meet artists and composers from the French and European jazz scene and to learn to work in an orchestra.

This ensemble is dedicated to the reinterpretation of the repertoires of the French Orchestre National de Jazz since its creation, with the ambition of enhancing the great richness of this heritage, of transmitting it to new generations of artists and of making it discoverable to new audiences. Each season, the direction of the orchestra is entrusted to a former musical director of the ONJ. Since 2018, three of them have succeeded each other as conductors: saxophonist François Jeanneau (ONJ 1986), vibraphonist Franck Tortiller (ONJ 2005-2008) and pianist Denis Badault (ONJ 1994-1997). In addition, the ONJ Youth Orchestra helps to identify new talent and to recruit soloists for the Orchestre National de Jazz.

For this new season, Laurent Cugny, pianist, arranger and musical director of the Orchestre National de Jazz from 1994 to 1997, will be the musical director of the Youth Orchestra. During his tenure, as a great expert of Gil Evans, he has attempted to offer a repertoire mixing original compositions and singular rereadings of classical jazz and blues (Fletcher Henderson, Miles Davis, Lalo Schifrin...). His project for the Youth Orchestra will consist of both the appropriation of the music of his ONJ by a new generation of musicians and the interpretation of unpublished sequences that were not recorded at the time.

As in previous seasons, the orchestra will perform in concerts (6 per season on average).

INSTRUMENTATION

14 musicians:

- 3 saxophones* including 1 alto / soprano 1 tenor 1 baritone
- * In your application, please specify if you play other saxophones than the one you are applying for.
- 1 flute / alto flute / piccolo
- 3 trumpets
- 1 trombone
- 1 horn
- 1 tuba
- 1 synthesizer / machines
- 1 electric guitar
- 1 electric bass
- 1 drum set

In addition to being the musical director, Laurent Cugny will play the Fender Rhodes in the orchestra. This year, unsolicited applications from other instrumentalists will not be considered.

CALENDAR

5 sessions of rehearsals, concerts and extra-musical training are planned between January and July 2023.

Session dates:

- February 16, 17 and 18 Médiathèque musicale, CRR de Paris, Sorbonne University (75)
- March 31, April 1 and 2 CMAD of Dunkerque (59)
- May 31, June 1, 2 and 3 Maison de la Culture of Amiens (80)
- July 7 and 8 CRD and Saint-Omer Jaaz Festival (62)

For this season, the residencies will take place mainly in the **Hauts-de-France region**. They will also be the occasion of several cultural actions and extra-musical trainings in connection with local partners.

APPLICATION FORM

- · A Resume (CV).
- · A letter of motivation.
- Two video excerpts in which the candidate plays and improvises (improvisation not required for horn and tuba), or alternatively 2 audio recordings.

At least one of the two excerpts must present the candidate in a group context. For drummers, both must be in a group context, one of which must be in an orchestra if possible.

MODALITIES

- Only adults (over 18 years old) and students are allowed to apply.

The video and audio files are to be sent only by WeTransfer – no other transmission channel is accepted.

Audios: 10 Mb maximum / Videos: 100 Mb maximum.

Please specify your name, first name and the name of the instrument played in the name of the files.

- Travel, lodging and meals are provided by the ONJ.
- Concert and recording activities are paid for. Rehearsals, considered as training time, are subject to an agreement with the partner schools.

As part of the ONJ's active policy of restoring gender parity in jazz orchestras, we strongly encourage women to apply.

Application deadline: Sunday, October 9, 2022.
